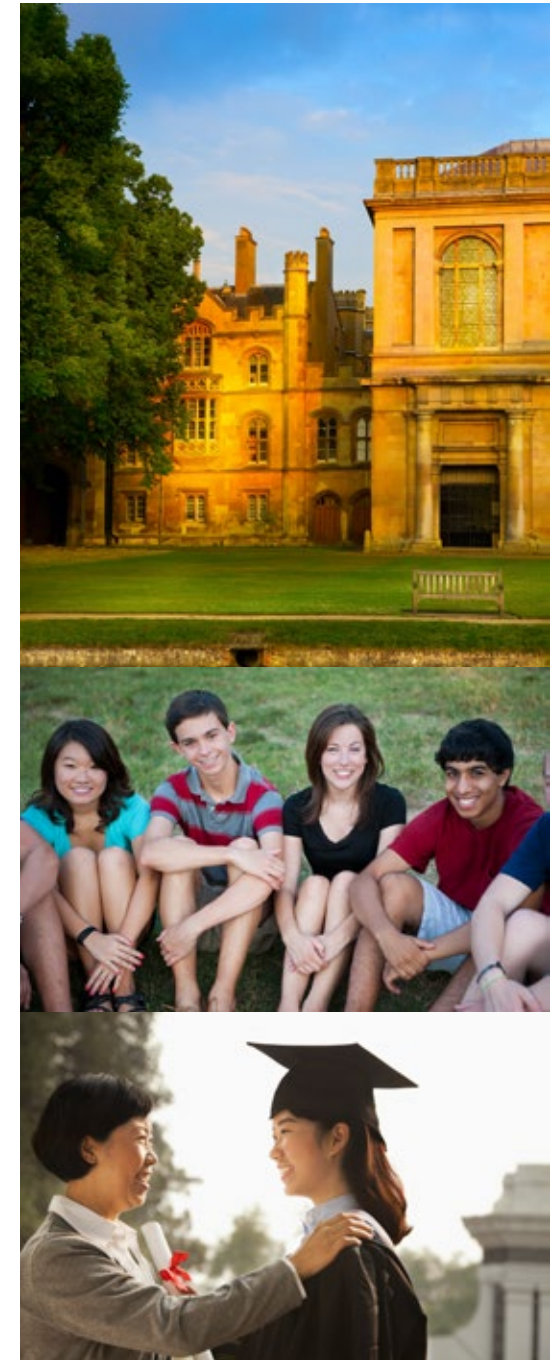

ABOUT CAMBRIDGE

Cambridge is one of the most ancient and distinguished universities in the world, renowned for its ground-breaking scientific research, its rich literary history and its architectural beauty.

For over eight hundred years, its tranquil college courtyards have been home to the highest levels of learning and scholarship.

Cambridge is consistently rated one of the top universities in the world in terms of its academic reputation and the employability of its students. Cambridge's degree courses are taught by experts who are world leaders in their fields of research. The time you spend in Cambridge will be a highly rewarding and enjoyable experience, whether you are studying on a short course or as a full-time undergraduate if you are successful in your application.

Cambridge is a collegiate University with 31 colleges, of which 29 colleges admit undergraduates. Teaching is shared between the colleges and University departments (faculties). Each college is an independent institution which appoints its own staff and is responsible for selecting students, in accordance with University regulations.

Almost all undergraduates live in college accommodation for the duration of their degree studies, either in undergraduate rooms or in nearby college houses. At the end of the day, students come together to dine, relax with friends and exchange ideas in the spectacular surroundings of their College Hall.

In addition to resources provided by the University, each college has its own library, chapel, sports facilities, computer room, clubs and societies, offering a variety of non-academic activities for students to enjoy. Colleges typically have gardens where students can study in the fresh air, relax, play croquet, dance at a May Ball, or any of the other myriad of classic summer activities that students in Cambridge can enjoy.
